冬になると餌を求め、人里に舞い降りるタンチョウ。アイヌ語でサルルンカムイ (湿原の神)と呼ばれ、翼を広げると2メートルを優に超す優雅な舞に寒さも 忘れる。上空からはオジロワシが餌を奪いにやって来た! さあ、タンチョウとオ ジロワシの争奪戦が始まる。ここでしか見られない、特別な瞬間を見逃すな!

In the winter, red-crowned cranes move to human habitation in search of food. In the Ainu language, the red-crowned crane is known as Sarurun Kamuy (the god of the marshes). They have a wingspan of more than 2m and their elegant dance will drive away the cold. A white-tailed eagle swoops in to steal food from red-crowned cranes! Let the battle commence between them. Do not miss the special moment that can only be seen here!
